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VICTIMS' RIGHTS WEEK – ART DISPLAY SUBMISSION
GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

For one week each year in April, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office in conjunction with national victims' rights groups celebrates the strengths and resiliency of crime victims. This year April 22 to 28 marks Victims' Rights Week. In keeping with this year's theme "Extending the Vision to Reaching Every Victim", the Cook County State's Attorney's Office seeks to recognize crime victims through a series of public service presentations, a Victim Service Awards Ceremony, and an art exhibit.

We are putting out a call for art submissions in a variety of mediums. Each submission must embody the theme "Extending the Vision to Reaching Every Victim". Additional theme information can be found at: <http://ovc.ncjrs.gov/ncvrw2012/index.html>. All art must be original.

Each individual submission must be accompanied by an individual application. Art submissions will be judged by a panel of experts and community members for its interpretation of the theme. Accepted pieces will be exhibited at the Richard J. Daley Center in downtown Chicago during normal business hours during Victims' Rights Week, April 22 to 28, 2012. Other entries will be on display at our Community Justice Centers throughout the week.

Please submit application with a photo of the original art piece to saogrants@cookcountyil.gov or you can drop off the application with photo of the art piece to one of four CJs throughout the city. Submission deadline is **March 26, 2012**. Entrants will be notified of acceptance into the public art display by April 9, 2012. At the conclusion of National Crime Victims' Rights week, artists may pick up their pieces at the designated CJC.
